GUIDE FOR COACHES & PARTICIPANTS

COACHES

If you have any child protection concerns regarding children or safeguarding concerns involving staff and adults, you must report them promptly and directly to the school's Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) or headteacher.

If you have any safeguarding concerns about a headteacher or DSL, you must promptly report them to the school's local authority designated offer (LADO)-contact details should be available in the school's safeguarding and child protection policies.

All safeguarding concerns should be reported to a DSL/headteacher or LADO, and the Accelerate Team notified that this has occurred. Any details should not be disclosed to anyone other than the DSL/Headteacher, LADO or Local Authority Children Services Team, as appropriate.
